Members are appointed to 3 year terms

Are expected to:

- sit on a committee
- participate in council events/ activities
- attend 4 full council meetings a year
 - Commit to 2-4 hours/month

Meetings are remote or in person

Reimbursement for travel

NHCDD Council Committees

- Policy

Keeps the Council updated on laws and policies that affect people with developmental disabilities and their families.
Develops official Council positions on policy.

- Member Relations

Recruits members and helps Council members to remain active and engaged.

- Finance

Advises the Council on the development and execution of the annual budget.

- Program and Planning

Advises the Council on the Small Grant Program and approves applications.
